

Lumen Christi Catholic School Lunch Charge Policy

School Lunch accounts can be funded in the following methods:

- SendMoneyToSchool.com. Deposit funds electronically here by typing directly into browser or going to the Lumen Christi webpage and clicking Students>School Lunch>Online Payment.
- Check (preferred) or cash turned into the office before or after school.

It is strongly encouraged that parents/guardians make meal payments in advance.

If you are unable to pay for meals due to your economic situation, please contact the Food Services Manager, Michelle Hineman. Assistance may be available and eligible recipients will receive the regular school lunch at a free or reduced cost. To complete a Free and Reduced Lunch application, use the link on the Lumen Christi's website by clicking Students>School Lunch>Apply Online or go directly to LunchApp.com.

We discourage meal charges, but we understand that an occasional emergency makes it necessary. The following policies will apply regarding charges.

Middle School and High School (7-12)

- A student is allowed to charge up to two meals (\$7 for middle school/\$8 for high school). After the second lunch is charged, money must be sent to pay the charges. Parents will receive an email or phone call at this time to see if assistance is needed.
- Parents of students who have a negative balance exceeding the cost of two meals will begin receiving email notifications from Meal Magic of the delinquent lunch account status.
- Please note: A negative lunch account balance will not be added to your tuition balance. Additionally, unpaid lunch balances will be subject to the collection procedures as outlined in the school's Bad Debt Policy.
- Cash will not be accepted at the time of lunch service.
